2006 Scouting for Food Drive--November 4, 8, and 11, 2005

Participation in this event is mandatory in order to attend any of the Troop's winter skiing events. Full Class A Uniforms are required for both the bag distribution and collection. This event has three parts--bag distribution, sign installation, and food collection. Sign installation are reserved for those few Scouts who are unable to make the bag distribution or collection days because of other Troop events, sports, or similar conflicts. We need 26 Scouts and 13 adults for bag distribution, 6 Scouts and 3 adults for sign installation, and 26 Scouts and 13 adults for food collection. Senior Scouts may also volunteer at the sorting center from 9:00 til 3:00 on November 11th if they want to earn extra Leadership Credits or to qualify for a Day Event (5 hour minimum). Meet at Parish Center at 9:00 a.m. on 11/5 for bag distribution. Sign installation 11/9, time TBA (about 3:30 pm). Food collection must take place on Saturday, 11/12, and will start at 9:00 a.m., regardless of weather conditions (the food collection trucks leave the collection areas early that afternoon). Food collection rarely takes more than 2 hours start to finish, and sign collection must be done immediately after food collection is finished. **Many adult drivers/monitors are needed for all three stages of this event (minimum 13 each weekend)!
