Killington Snow Sports Trek 2006, Tuesday-Saturday, December 26-30, 2006

MANDATORY SCOUTING FOR FOOD REQUIREMENT: Participants in any Tr111 Snow Sports Trip **MUST** participate in some aspect of Scouting for Food. This year's dates are: **NOV 4** and/or **NOV 11**.

MANDATORY ORIENTATION MEETING: **MON, DEC 18, 2006, approx. 8:30pm**, Participants must attend this **mandatory** orientation meeting in St. Agnes Parish Center.

ASSEMBLY: **TUE, DEC 26, 2006, 5:00am** St. Agnes Parish Center parking lot. **Don't be late**; the troop won't wait!! Due to various rush hours we potentially encounter throughout our route, a timely departure is critical...even though it's DEC 26!

RETURN: **SAT, DEC 30, 2006, 7pm (approx.)** Obviously a function of weather, traffic & winter road conditions. Expect a phone or e-mail message SAT afternoon based on word from the travelers.

EQUIPMENT: NO sleeping bags or pads or mess kits are required. Trailside Lodge (www.trailsidelodge.com) provides sheets, blanket, pillow, towel and a hot breakfast and 4-course dinner each day. Pack appropriate clothing for 5 days away including 3 FULL days on the slopes. Pack clothes that can be variably layered depending on weather conditions. Thermal underwear, thermal socks, snow parka, snow pants, hats that cover ears, goggles, mittens, gloves, boots, etc. Avoid cotton clothing! Don't forget your SWIMSUIT, a hot tub & heated pool are available.

UNIFORM: None required this year, since we will not be attending Mass.

CASH-IN-HAND: Participants should have approx. \$75 cash in hand for meals in route and slope-side lunches, which tend to be pricey. If desired, an adult "banker" will be available to safeguard cash for youths.
