This is guaranteed to be a fun filled weekend!! We have slope side cabins with 40 bunks total. Space is limited and will be first come first serve. We will depart St Agnes at 4 PM SHARP and stop for a quick fast food dinner on the way and arrive at Seven Springs Friday night. We will ski / snowboard all day Saturday and Sunday. Night skiing/boarding will also be available both evenings. Each attendee will receive a voucher for breakfast and dinner in the lodge per day. Lunch and snacks will be available in the cabins along with refreshments. The troop will depart Monday morning and have a fast food lunch stop on the way home approx arrival time 2pm.
