Beginner Ski/Snowboarding Trip, Saturday, December 16, 2006—Whitetail

*****Please note: All beginners must attend the orientation meeting*****

This trip is for beginner/low intermediate skiers and beginner/intermediate snowboarders. Advanced skiers/snowboarders may attend if they are willing to assist with teaching/supervising less experienced Scouts. The Troop will be skiing at Whitetail Ski Resort. Scouts should assemble at 5:45 a.m. sharp at the Parish Center. Lunch vouchers will be provided at Whitetail. Dinner at the Hagerstown Pizza Hut is included in the above rates. Return to the Parish Center about 7 p.m.

All beginner skiers will receive a thorough (and free!) lesson from Dr. Bob with assistance from experienced senior Scouts/adults. Fast learners will be released quickly and shepherded on the slopes by senior Scout teachers, while careful learners will continue to work with Dr. Bob until they get the hang of it. The same drill will be used with those Scouts wishing to learn snowboarding. The buddy system will be in effect; Scouts are responsible for matching themselves up (and re-matching by ability/speed/level as the day goes on). Senior Scouts attending to teach will earn leadership credits based on their level of commitment to instruct. No violations of the buddy system will be allowed--lift tickets will be confiscated if Scouts fail to buddy up.

SCOUTS SHOULD DRESS WARMLY IN LAYERS: SKI PARKA/PANTS, GLOVES, HAT TO COVER EARS, WARM SOCKS, GOGGLES (optional). REMEMBER IT WILL BE COLDER (10-20 DEGREES) THAN IN ARLINGTON!
